

Three variations of lute tablature:

- 1)** Shows a sequence of notes: δ, δ, b, δ, b.
- 2)** Shows a sequence of notes: [a], δ, δ, a, δ.
- 3)** Shows a sequence of notes: δ, δ, δ, δ, δ.
